Fishing from Winter Harbour is as good as it gets on the West Coast !

Chinook salmon average 25-35 pounds with many over 40 pounds. Catching your daily limit is usual. Awesome Coho runs in the later season. Halibut, Ling Cod and other bottom fish are plentiful.

Fishing Charters:

4 nights with 3-8 hour days of guided fishing

Trips include lodging, meals, fish processing and freezing, guided fishing, tackle and bait.

\$2,250 CAN / per person based on 3 guests

\$2,750 CAN / per person based on 2 guests

Three bedroom apartment next to marina – sleeps 6
includes freezer for your fish.

\$250- \$300 /night – Reservations a must

Two bedroom cabin – small and quaint, sleeps 4

Fully furnished and includes Bbq, picnic table, and fish freezer.

\$150- \$200 /night – Call for reservations.

Moorage Rates from \$10.00per day

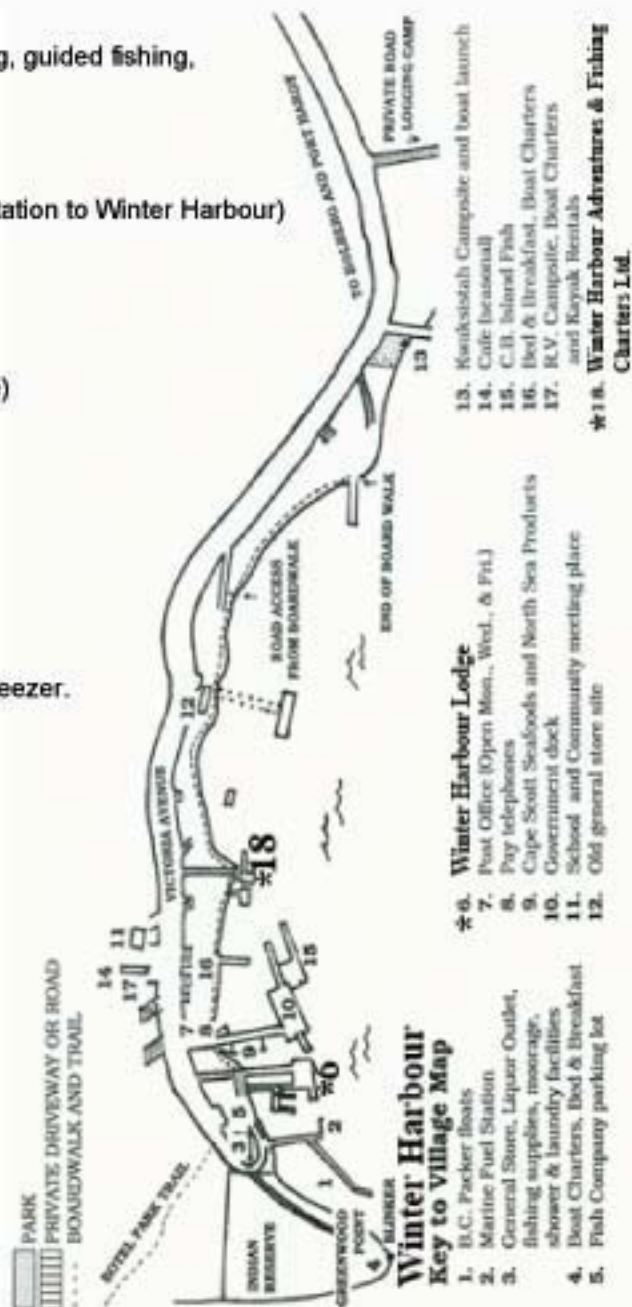
PAYMENT:

Winter Harbour - Where We Are

Location: Winter Harbour is located a 40-minute drive south of Holberg on northern Vancouver Island. Highway 19, the main highway serving Vancouver Island, links Port Hardy with Victoria and all other major centres on the island. Other communities in the North Island, including Coal Harbour, Holberg and Port Alice, are connected to Port Hardy by well-maintained highways.

74 km from Port Hardy (2 hour drive)
24 km past Holberg
Coal Harbour - (2 hours boat ride)
